



Work order management

- generating orders on the basis of different order types:
 - work order with measures
allocation of one or more measures
 - work order with positions
documentation in the form of actual material and wage positions
 - small work order
without detailed documentation for quick processing
- collection of measures belonging to a work order
- order processing in different stages, also distributed onto different roles
- integrated order forms which can be printed, partly with detailed check lists based on activities
- process-dependant configurations of functions
- allocation of orders to budgets and objects allowing efficient cost control
- simple capture of invoices and adaption of actual costs via automatic calculations

Budget management

- creating hierarchical budgets with partial budgets and individual budgets including cost schedule
- integrated budget overviews with display of budget status
- comparison of target and actual costs depending on the status of the work order
- comparison of target and actual costs for work orders
- comprehensive evaluation functions with export to Excel and Access, also into pre-configured templates
